








THE YOUTH HEALTH SUPPORT INITIATIVE





THE YHSI

The app will connect users with a team of volunteer experts from various medical fields who will provide confidential and professional advice to address their concerns.

The anonymous nature of the app will create a judgment-free environment, encouraging youth to seek the support they need without fear or stigma







THE YHSI

Key features of the YHSI app will include:










KEY SPORTING ACTIVITIES

FUND-A-UNIFORM

Many South African children are without a proper school Uniform.

- This project is aimed at helping thousands of children who are without school uniform every year.
- Some even go barefoot or with either torn clothes to school. In winter it's a hardened situation that kids find themselves in.
- With this project we want to avoid having children not attend school because of a lack of school Uniform.







GIRLS AND PADS DRIVE

In South Africa, over 3.7 million young girls are affected by the lack of sanitary towels which forces many of them to miss school on certain days a month. Unfortunately, this pattern may affect the child's educational development.

Some girls who cant afford to buy female hygiene products usually find themselves resorting to rags, socks, even newspapers, and often lack access to clean water and private toilet facilities.







We aim to provide at least 100 000 girls across the country every year.

This project aims at providing young school girls with Sanitary products for 12 months.





Our Request

We seek support in terms of funding, sponsorships and donations to be able to reach out to as many people. This will aid in the development of our youth and also cater to those that are in need under different circumstances.

There are many more activities that we as an organization intend to engage as they are all directed at the development and empowerment of our communities which will in turn help them lead productive lives and also help them become contributing members of our South African economy.

This will in turn also help us create employment for many that are without jobs.





Kids Coding Club

- Partner with Schools and public Libraries to use their computer labs.
- Deploy coding facilitators to teach the Children.
- Engage at least 50 000 children between ages 5 to 16 whom will be interested in learning how to code.
- Create a platform that will allow the children to use their acquired skills to innovate themselves.





The YOUTH HEALTH SUPPORT INITIATIVE

- Partner with teams of qualified Doctors in their respective fields.
- Partner with reputable private clinics.
- Make the YHSI app available on all popular app stores, including Android, Harmony, and iOS for free.
- The youth will use the app to have their free consultation anonymously.







Sports Academy

- Partner with sports companies and administrators in delivering state of the art sport training services which include facilities, human resources and training kits.
- Deploy coaching experts to various training centers across selected provinces.
- Engage at least 10 000 children between ages 5 to 17 in their choice sporting activities with more focus on soccer as it is the most popular sport today.
- Create a calendar of local and international competitions as an exposure roadmap for the children.
- Showcase the young stars talent by involving various talent scouts across the world which serves as a career building opportunity for the children.



Seniors Fitness Programme

- Partner with fitness centers and trainer to help and sponsor with training equipment.
- Partner with Retailers to sponsor meals and/or refreshments for the seniors after their training.
- Approach local community centers for venues.
- Engage with as many seniors to be part of the programme.





Skills & Vocational Training for Vulnerable (At-Risk) Members of Society

- Partner with renowned or reputable private higher educational institutions in the TVET FET sector.
- Equip participants with the necessary skills and grant them certificates.
- Help them to be gainfully employed.





Fund-A-Uniform

- Reach out to different schools across all provinces that will help identify the children that are in need of school uniform but cannot afford it.
- Partner with certain retailers to assist in the provision of the school uniform.
- Give out the uniforms to identified children in need.
- Provide at least 100 000 school children with uniform every year.





Girls and Pads Drive

- Partner with Sanitary pad companies to assist in providing sanitary products.
- Acquire sufficient amount of pads to meet our target.
- Approach schools and engage with girls on menstrual education.
- Work with the department of health to help teach girls about personal hygiene.
- Help at least 100 000 girls every year with sanitary towels.
